

## **ADVANSIX KICKS OFF SPRING BY PARTICIPATING IN REBUILDING TOGETHER PROJECT IN RICHMOND**

*Team Helps Local Resident with Much-Needed Home Improvements and Repairs*

**Chesterfield, Va., March 26, 2018** – On Saturday, March 24, more than 30 AdvanSix employees kicked off Spring by participating in community service project in Richmond as part of Rebuilding Together's National Rebuilding Month effort. The team helped a local resident spruce up his home, including repairs to the home's front and back porches, various lighting improvements, and minor electrical repairs.

One of the company's contractors, Turner Industries, replaced a bathroom floor and installed a new sink and handicap-accessible toilet donated by Wolseley Industrial Group, an AdvanSix pipe, valve and fitting supplier.

"AdvanSix is proud to be a part of Rebuilding Together's efforts in the Richmond and Tri-Cities area. Our team brings its engineering skills, work ethic and overall enthusiasm to the projects and the best part is we get to help a deserving family," said Dorene Billingsley, director of Integrated Supply Chain at AdvanSix. "As we move into the spring season, it was a great chance to get outside, and to give back to our community."

This is the third local Rebuilding Together project AdvanSix has done over the past 12 months. The company has also made a \$10,000 donation to the organization to support its mission of helping people by repairing homes, revitalizing communities and rebuilding lives.

More than 1000 people work at AdvanSix's Richmond-area facilities. The Hopewell site is one of the world's largest single-site producers of caprolactam, a primary feedstock for nylon polymers, and a global leader in the production of ammonium sulfate fertilizers. The company's Chesterfield plant is the second-largest site in the United States dedicated to Nylon 6 resin production, and the company has a research & development team located in Colonial Heights.
