



Political Contribution Policy Statement

AdvanSix Inc. (the “**Company**”) and its leadership are committed to supporting and strengthening its business and political relationships with key decision and policy makers, and to provide a platform to educate public officials about the Company and the chemical industry in general. This Political Contribution Policy (“**Policy**”) applies worldwide to the Company, its affiliates, and its other business associations that are effectively controlled by the Company, directly or indirectly, and all directors, officers, and employees of the Company.

The Company and its directors, officers, employees, and contractors are prohibited from using Company funds, property, services, influence, or any other thing of value for or in aid of, or in opposition to, (i) any political parties, campaign committees, or candidates for public office, or (ii) any committee, grass roots organization, or other group or organization whose principal purpose is to influence the outcome of a ballot initiative, referendum or other vote of the electorate on a public issue (collectively, “**Political Contributions**”). The Company will not provide Political Contributions or engage in any activity that could create the appearance of bribery, undue influence, or other corrupt practices. Employees may volunteer their own time to assist a candidate, a campaign committee, a political party, a grass roots organization, or other group. However, employee worktime, Company facilities, support services, office supplies, computers, electronic mail access, etc., shall not, under any circumstances, be utilized in such an effort.

The Company sponsors an employee political action committee as permitted by applicable law and pursuant to by-laws or other governing instruments and as approved by the General Counsel. The AdvanSix Inc. Political Action Committee (“**SIXPAC**”), which has been approved and sponsored, as a voluntary, non-partisan employee political action committee may, pursuant to U.S. and state law, collect and disburse contributions to U.S. candidates for public office and political parties. Through SIXPAC, the pooled resources of Company employees are a powerful tool to provide non-partisan support to candidates who are pro-business and will promote legislation in support of the Company’s growth, our employees, key customers and suppliers, and who hold key committee or leadership posts in Congress. Requests for Political Contributions should be directed to the Director of Government Relations and/or SIXPAC, which will thereafter evaluate such request and determine whether to distribute any funds for such request based on the SIXPAC operating guidelines.

AdvanSix is firmly committed to compliance with the Political Contribution Policy to provide transparent and non-partisan support of public officials who wish to understand and support our success.
